



Q1 Do you support a statewide mask mandate for all indoor gatherings in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic?





Q2 Do you support the Whitmer administration's recent restrictions closing indoor dining, moving high schools and colleges to all virtual learning, and closing entertainment venues?





Q3 What measures should be taken to help curb the spread of COVID-19?(Pick your top three)





Q4 How has your business been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic? (Check all that apply)





Q5 Do you anticipate any changes to your business during the second wave of the pandemic? (Choose all that apply)





Q6 Do you see the need for a more coordinated federal response to the pandemic?





Q7 Should federal lawmakers approve another round of stimulus funding?





Q8 Should the federal government extend the \$600/week unemployment benefit?





Q9 Do you agree with economists who say the economy won't fully recover until the virus is under control?






